



The Salvatorians recognise the importance of training in identifying and responding to abuse and welfare concerns. Safeguarding training is one of the most effective ways to ensure that Salvatorians and Co-workers are aware of safeguarding policies, procedures and their duty of care to the children and people at risk.

In keeping with best practice:

- All Salvatorians in ministry in a Diocese will undertake the training provided by the Diocese and send a copy of their certificate of attendance to the Provincial Secretary for filing.
- The Salvatorians will have their own annual training event – a list of attendees will be kept by the Provincial Secretary
- On-line training is recommended for all Salvatorians and their co-workers and RLSS training is available as necessary.
- A list of the training of all Salvatorians will be kept on file
- A copy of Salvatorian training will be kept on file
